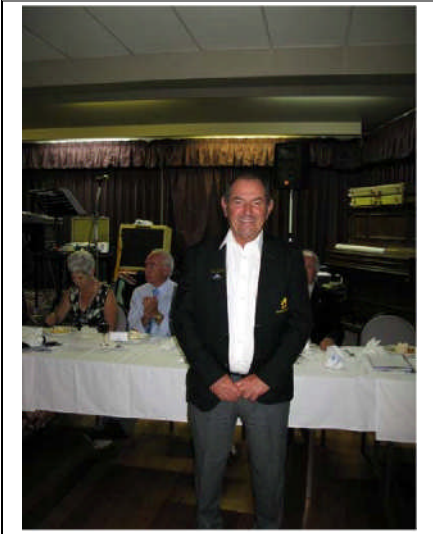
Rumours are circulating that:
